Session summary

The meeting updated the group on the progress of the Phillip Island Community Hospital and consulted them on gaps in services within the context of safety and capability, as well as an overview of current services at the Phillip Island Health Hub. The project team presented an overview of the Victorian hospital system and the local health context, reported back on engagement and communications activities to date, shared results from the October 2019 state-wide community survey and November 2019 service model design workshops, and responded to questions about the project.
