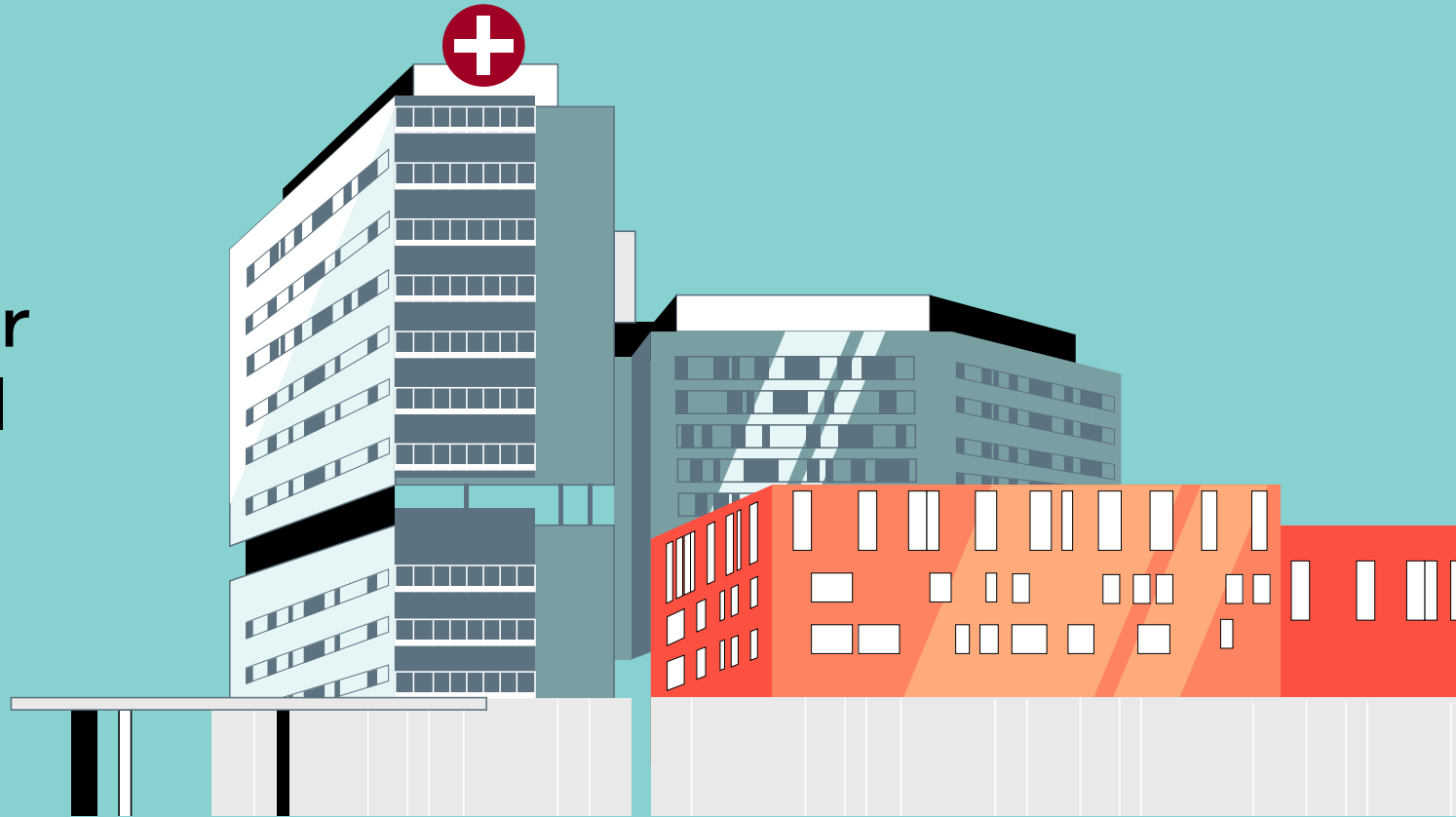
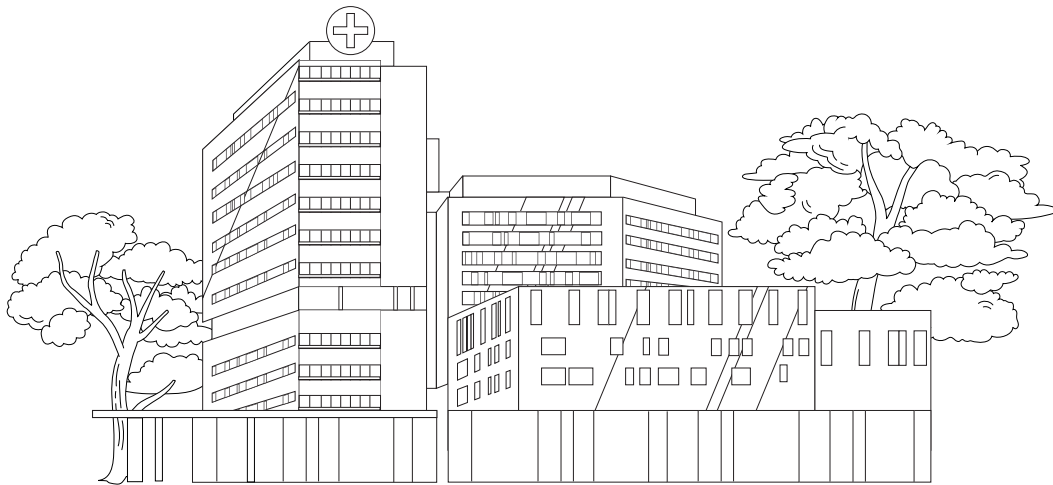

A bigger and better Frankston Hospital Colouring book

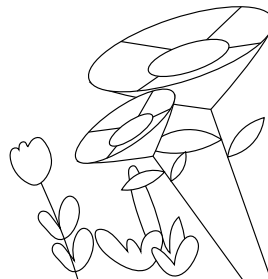


We're building a new hospital tower at Frankston Hospital. It will have 12 levels for patients and a helipad on the roof!



Did you know?

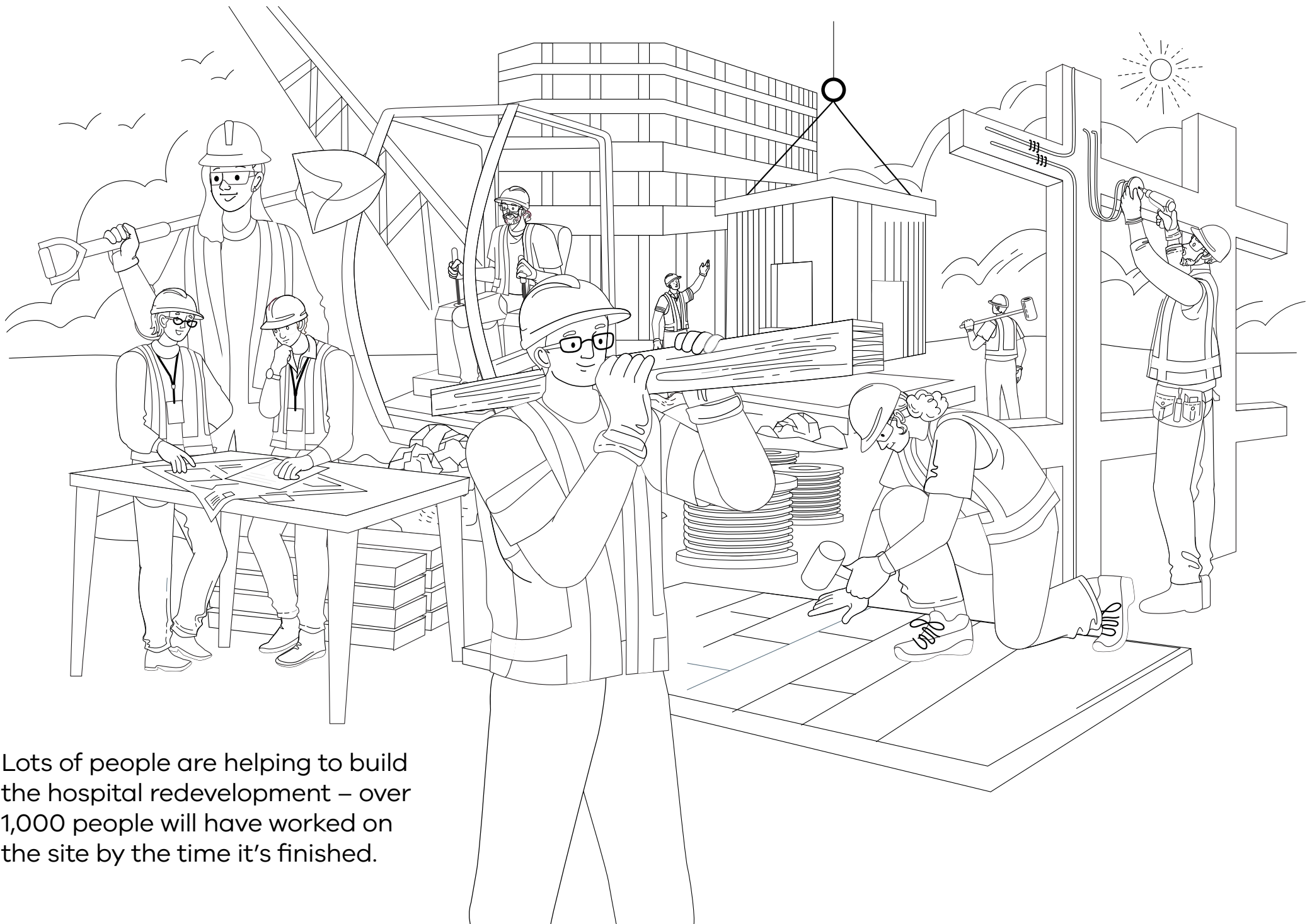
Frankston Hospital was built in 1941. Back then it only had 32 beds!



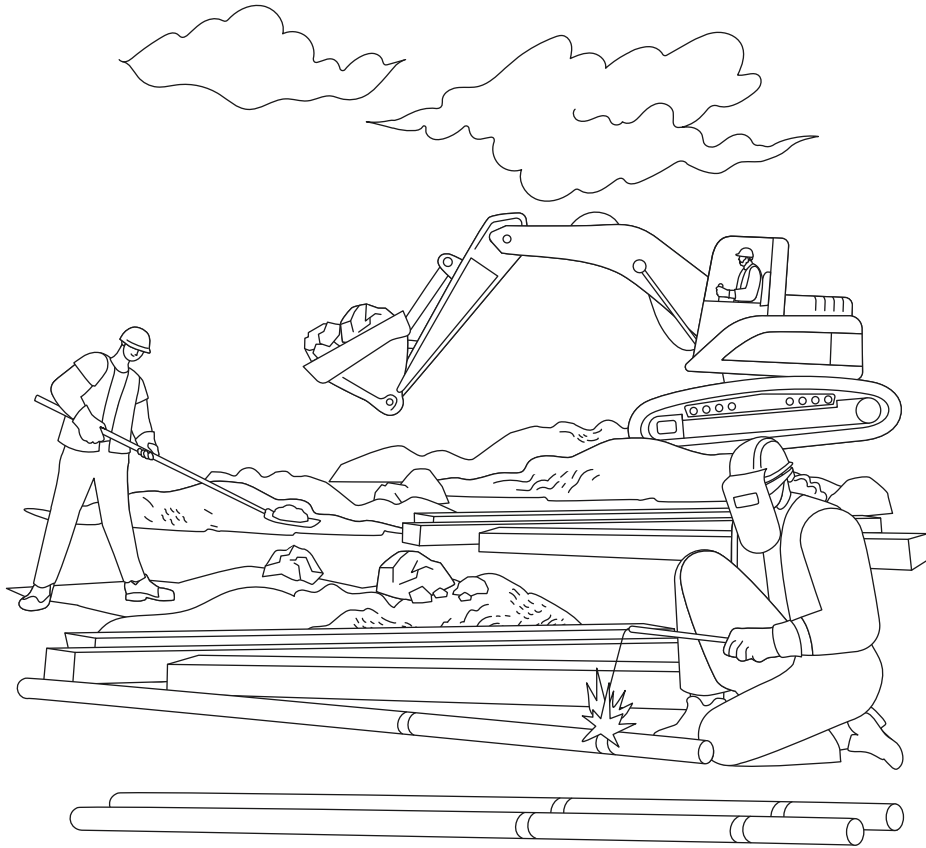
When we're finished upgrading Frankston Hospital it will be much bigger. There will be space to treat 35,000 more patients every year.

Lots of people are helping to build the hospital redevelopment – over 1,000 people will have worked on the site by the time it's finished.

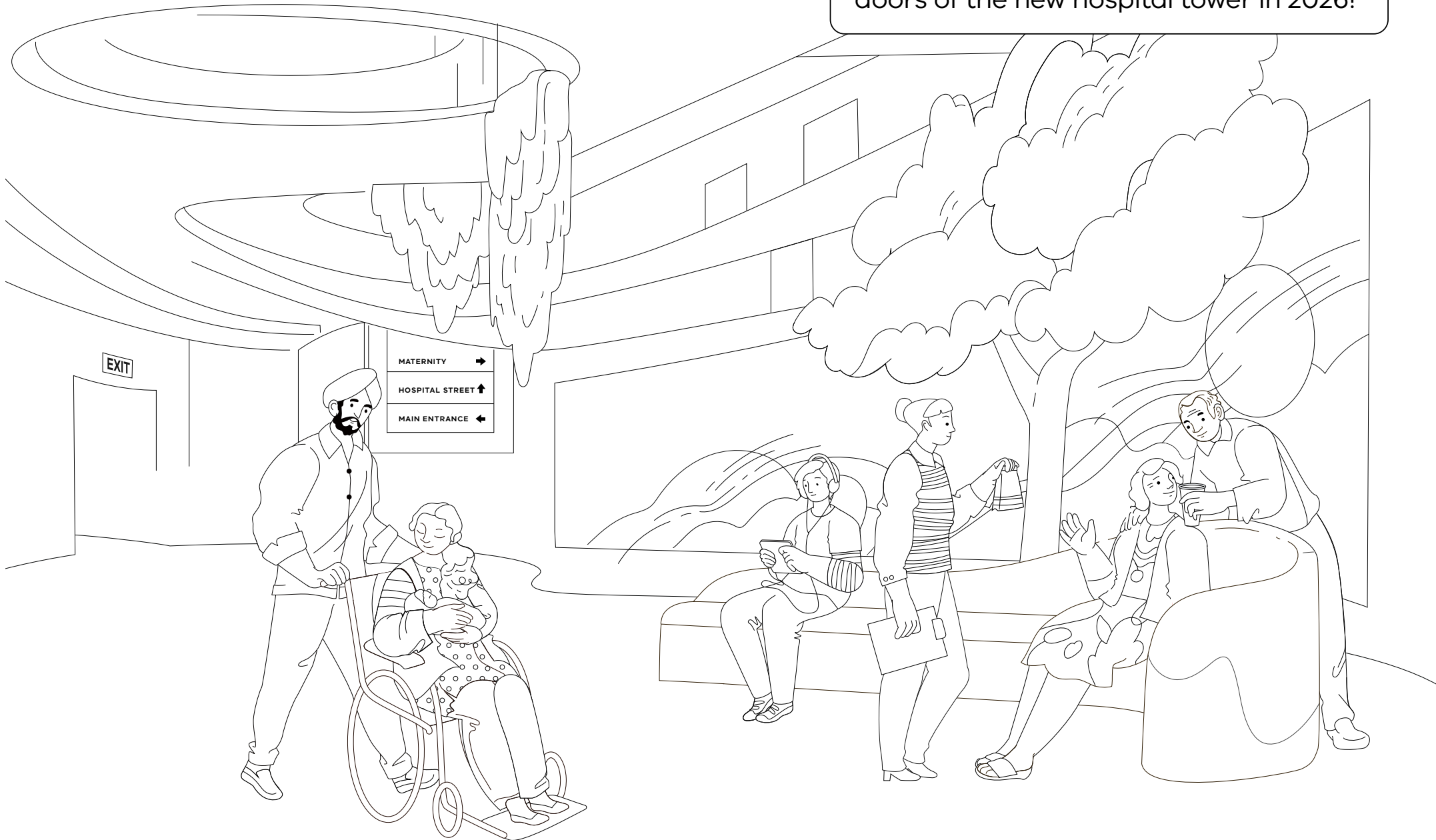


The construction workers need special tools and machinery, like diggers, to do their jobs.
